

ROBERT P. DEMOTT, Ph.D., DABT



Bob DeMott is a board-certified toxicologist with the consulting firm ENVIRON, and his practice focuses on evaluating exposures to chemicals in the environment and workplace. His research linked products from corrosive imported drywall to failed air conditioning systems and characterized indoor air quality. He has directed studies to identify unique characteristics of this material and the mechanisms producing corrosive

chemicals.

Dr. DeMott is a diplomate of the American Board of Toxicology and completed post-doctoral training at the Center for Human and Environmental Toxicology at the University of Florida. He holds a Ph.D. in Physiological Science from UF and a B.A. in Biology from Williams College.

Dr. DeMott's expertise includes the toxicology of chemical mixtures, environmental risk analysis, and reproductive toxicology. He evaluates the potential for health effects to have been caused by chemical exposures and has worked on exposures involving acid gases and other airborne irritants for more than 15 years.
