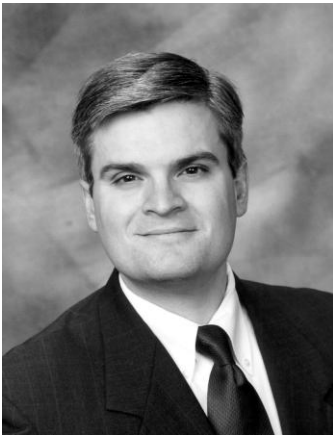




TONY WORTHAN, MPH
